***DELTA FARMLAND & WILDLIFE TRUST CONDITIONAL
 FIELD LIMING COST SHARE AGREEMENT***

BETWEEN THE CO-OPERATOR:

AND

THE DELTA FARMLAND AND WILDLIFE TRUST, a non-profit, community based, charitable society, whose mission is to promote the preservation of farmland and associated wildlife habitat in the Fraser River delta through sustainable farming and land stewardship (referred hereinafter as the "DF&WT").

WHEREAS: the Co-operator and DF&WT have agreed to cost share the liming of agricultural fields within the Municipality of Delta, in the Province of British Columbia

THE CO-OPERATOR WILL:

- 1) apply lime to the field(s) described in Schedule A, in order to be eligible for the DF&WT Field Liming Program funding.
- 2) ensure that fields described in Schedule A are limed **by October 31st, 2017**,
- 3) notify DF&WT if the liming cannot be performed by October 31, 2017,
- 4) if planning to apply the lime themselves, provide a receipt for lime applied to field(s) described in Schedule A.
- 5) if contracting the application of lime to a third party, provide a receipt indicating acreage and application rate for the field(s) described in Schedule A.
- 6) abide by the following restrictions:
 - a) cooperator can apply for funding for a maximum of 100 metric tons of lime
 - b) any field described in Schedule A can only have a maximum of 2 tons of lime per acre funded under the program
- 7) indemnify and save harmless DF&WT from and against any and all actions, suits, claims, demands, damages and losses, howsoever arising as a result of the DF&WT Field Liming program.
- 8) **submit this application to DF&WT no later than November 3, 2017.**

DELTA FARMLAND & WILDLIFE TRUST WILL:

- 1) upon receipt of the Cooperator's proof of payment for lime applied to the field(s) described in Schedule A, rendered by **November 3, 2017**, cost share the lime application using the following calculation methods:
 - a maximum of \$30 per ton of lime (maximum of 2 tons per acre allowed under program)
 - less than \$30 per ton of lime will be paid out if DF&WT funding is insufficient to cover all liming agreements within the program in any one year. If this is the case, payment on all agreements in the program will be reduced by the same percentage.
- 2) make payment in late December 2017 for lime applied to the field(s) described in Schedule A.
